

Hello, Columbia Village neighbors.

I am the Columbia Village Neighborhood Watch coordinator/chairperson and am in need of block captains. The good news is that we are about halfway complete with ensuring there's a captain for every 'block' in the neighborhood.

The current set up for Neighborhood Watch within Columbia Village requires approx. 90-100 block captains to ensure all streets have a contact person. As I work through the list confirming that previous captains want to continue and also recruiting new captains for confirmation through Boise City for a light background check, I wanted to provide a list to the neighborhood of streets who either do not have a block captain identified or do not have a block captain confirmation in progress. The list below contains all the streets where I have no volunteer for captain of that street. If you are interested in taking one (or more) of the streets listed below, please let me know! I will work with you on next steps in getting approved as an official block captain. If your street is not in this list and you are curious who is your block captain, please let me know. The block captain list will be published on the CVOA website soon

What are the responsibilities of a Block Captain?

- Know your neighbors. Help your neighbors. Notice when things just aren't quite right and do something if needed. We'll talk about what that 'something' is once you're approved but it might include calling Carey Guard, non-emergency dispatch, or 911.
- Receive email updates from me.
- Be willing to communicate to your designated area as needed or communicate back to me on behalf of your block.
- Attend a meeting or two each year.
