

Columbia Village Homeowners Association Rec Center Pioneer Room Rules Pertaining to COVID-19

At the May 19, 2020 meeting, the Columbia Village Homeowners Board of Directors voted to open the Pioneer Room on **June 15, 2020**. Following the guidance and recommendations of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare and Governor Little's Idaho Rebounds plan, the Board has established rules and guidance to be followed by Columbia Village Homeowners in order to minimize the possibility of spreading COVID-19. This operational plan takes effect June 15, 2020 and will remain in effect until further notice.

Reservations

- Reservations are for **all-day only**. No half-day rentals. All day reservation hours are from **7 am – 9 pm**.
- Rental fee is \$80 for the all-day rental plus \$50 disinfecting/cleaning fee. A \$150 refundable deposit is required.

Rules

- Guests should engage in physical distancing of at least six feet
- Patrons must bring their own sanitizer/cleaning supplies
- Patrons must remove all garbage
- Patrons must exit promptly at 9 pm for cleaning staff to access the room
- No pool access when renting the Pioneer Room
- Bathrooms will be unlocked for use, but patrons are not allowed anywhere else in the Rec Center outside the Pioneer Room

Homeowner Responsibility

Pioneer patrons should:

- Engage in physical distancing of at least six feet
- Stay home if sick
- Practice good hand hygiene
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Disinfect commonly touched surfaces and objects regularly
- Bring own sanitization/disinfectant products as they will not be provided
- Please notify Sentry if anybody attending an event in the Pioneer Room tests positive for COVID-19 within two weeks of use of the room

Violation of the procedures and rules will result in cancellation of access to Rec Center. The Board of Directors reserves the right to close the Pioneer Room if it's determined safety and health guidelines cannot be met due to violations and issues.
