Rec Center Gym Rules Pertaining to COVID-19

At the September 15, 2020 meeting, the Columbia Village Homeowners Board of Directors voted to open the gym on **October 15, 2020**. Following the guidance and recommendations of the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare and Governor Little's Idaho Rebounds plan, the Board has established rules and guidance to be followed by Residents of Columbia Village Owners Association when using the gym and racquetball court at the Rec Center to minimize the possibility of spreading COVID-19. This operational plan takes effect October 15, 2020 and will remain in effect until further notice.

The following changes have been made within the Rec Center as a response to COVID-19:

- All CVOA furniture has been removed from the public room and is not available for use
- Most of the cardio equipment has been moved from the gym area to the public room to help with social distancing
- Certain hard-to-clean equipment such as yoga mats have been removed and will not be available
- The Rec Center will be cleaned daily starting at or around 9:00PM

Rec Center Use

- Hours of Operation – Daily from 5:00AM to 9:00PM
- The Rec Center is only open for gym and racquetball use only
- No organized gatherings or loitering are allowed within the Rec Center
- No food is allowed within the Rec Center
- The bathrooms in the Rec Center are open and will be cleaned/sanitized once a day
- No outside equipment is allowed
- Residents shall be responsible for wiping down equipment before and after each use
- Residents cannot enter the Rec Center when sick
- No reserving of the racquet ball court is allowed
 - Use of racquet ball court shall be limited to 45 minutes when others are waiting

Homeowner Responsibility

Rec Center patrons should:

- Engage in physical distancing of at least six feet
- Stay home if sick or if you have any symptoms (no matter how minor), or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- Practice good hand hygiene
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Disinfect commonly touched surfaces and objects regularly

Violation of the procedures and rules could result in loss of Rec Center access privileges. The Board of Directors reserves the right to close the Rec Center if it is determined safety and health guidelines cannot be met due to violations and issues.
